Principle Accountabilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Maintenance of all LPG pumps, tanks, pipelines up to and including regulators at all SOL Guyana Inc LPG Customers. Provide expert LPG advice to SOL Guyana Inc. LPG bulk and 100lb customers Provide frontline Customer relations for SOL Guyana Inc. Liaise with the LPG Sales Executive any potential new LPG business. Inspection, testing and replacement of LPG pipelines Assist with the inspection, testing and replacement of tanks and ancillary equipment. Assist the Maintenance engineer and the LPG Sales Executive in the design and installation of LPG tanks and ancillary equipment at LPG Customers. Testing delivery hoses and documenting of results. Records to be kept in centralized files and updated as required. In the event of an emergency provide crisis response maintenance on all SOL Guyana Inc equipment as required by the Crisis management team including but is not limited to LPG equipment, air meters, nozzles, hoses, commercial meters, dispensers, pay at the pump operations equipment, man-way access covers, fill points, tank vents, etc. Agree critical spare parts lists and the quantities required to minimize disruption of operations. Maintain all fixed and mobile equipment to minimize disruption of services and maximize asset life. Implement a system for tracking inspection/audit actions and ensuring timely close-out of the same. Pro-actively contribute to the safe conduct of all maintenance activity. Ensure full compliance with Sol Group Operating and Safety Procedures including Permit to Work. Ensure that all activities are in accordance with local legislation, industry codes and practices. Decide on equipment repair/replacement in collaboration with the Maintenance Engineer. Proactively report on conditions/actions that could negatively impact safe operations. Develop a preventable maintenance schedule for depot equipment e.g. pumps, compressors, valves, etc. Check all product storage vessels and equipment for leaks and maintain work areas free of oils and spills. Carry out preventive maintenance as directed on all drains, sumps, pipelines, fire systems, depot pumps and all other equipment as may be required from time to time. Attend safety and toolbox meetings and execute tasks as assigned. Assist with the monitoring and recording of pipeline pressures during transfers.



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participate in depot inspections and advise on maintenance related corrective actions. • Ensure that all HSE standards and practices are complied with in all work related activities. • Assist with and/ or participate in emergency exercises and drills at all SOL Guyana Inc. Depot facilities as required. Such exercises and drills may be in collaboration with other oil companies and the emergency services. • Assist in the preparation of operations improvement initiatives and execute related tasks as assigned. • Contribute to the ongoing development and refinement of all maintenance strategies and demonstrate commitment to those implemented. • Participate in Specific annual training in the areas of Loading and discharging from ships and trucks, pipeline operations, tank gauging, firefighting & electrostatic ignition. • Attend monthly HSSE meetings. • Ensure, through recorded tests that all back up pumps and equipment remain in working order. All records to be forwarded, through LPG Supervisor to central files. • Other duties as assigned by the Maintenance Engineer from time to time.
